



Can lighters be stored in airport lockers





Overview

When bringing your lighter through airport security, you must bring the lighter in your carry-on or on your person. Disposable and Zippo lighters without fuel are allowed in checked bags. Lighters with fuel are prohibited in checked bags, unless they adhere to the Department of Transportation exemption, which allows up to two fueled lighters if properly enclosed in a DOT approved case. The final decision rests. According to the FAA, when traveling on a commercial airline you can bring one lighter that uses a flammable gas (butane) or that uses a flammable liquid that is absorbed in a lining (Zippo-type of lighter). The rules can differ for international travel, but this article explains current U. expectations, common restrictions, and practical tips.

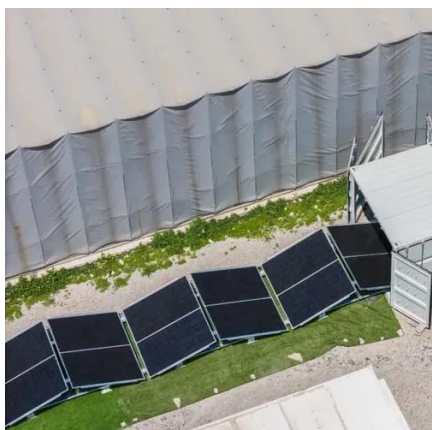
