



# Energy storage batteries exported from Zimbabwe





## Overview

---

Zimbabwe's lithium exports have increased, and this trend reflects the early effects of policies that promote domestic processing. According to official data, export volumes rose at a steady pace, while stronger output from active mines improved export flows. Africa's lithium sector development has accelerated beyond mineral extraction into sophisticated value-addition frameworks that reshape global battery supply chain dynamics. Processing infrastructure deployment across southern African jurisdictions demonstrates technical capacity building patterns. Harare - Zimbabwe has recorded an increase in exports of Lithium spodumene concentrate, exporting 586,197 metric tons in the first half of 2025, a 30% rise from the 451,824 tons recorded during the same period in 2024, according to data released by the Minerals Marketing Corporation of Zimbabwe. Zimbabwe lithium exports increased as Harare deepens its push for domestic value addition across the mining sector. Countries positioned to supply these minerals or critically, to refine and process them, are restructuring their economies around this new opportunity.

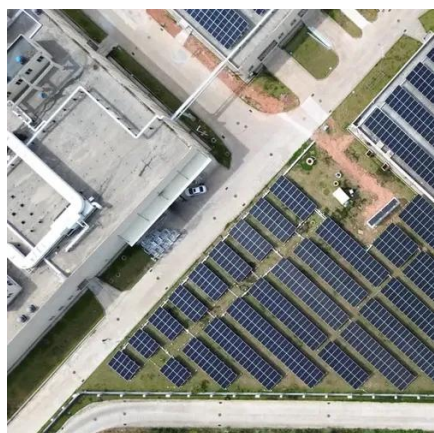
