The short answer is that most solar panels last 25 to 30 years. They don't stop working overnight. Instead, they gradually lose efficiency over time. Most are backed by 25- to 30-year performance warranties, and in real-world conditions, many keep producing power well beyond that. But lifespan isn't just about whether a panel still functions; it's about whether it's still delivering the return. Replacing solar panels isn't something you'll need to do often. Most panels continue to perform for 25 years or more with just basic maintenance. But like anything exposed to the elements, time takes its toll.

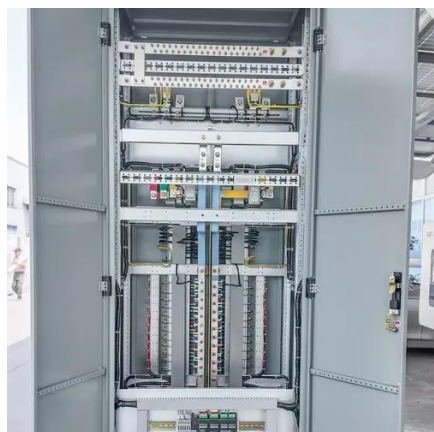
