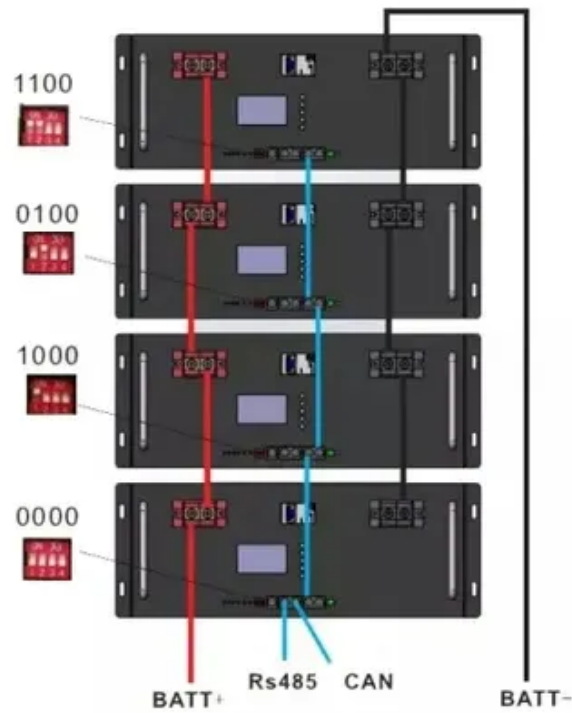




Photovoltaic panel project fraud

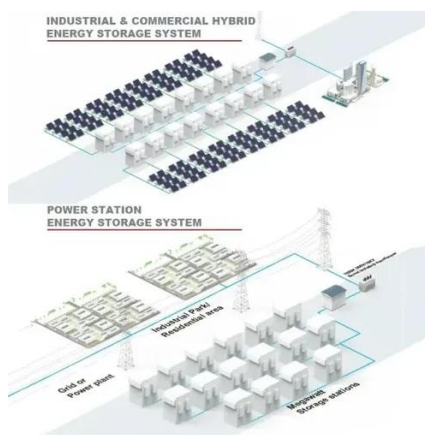

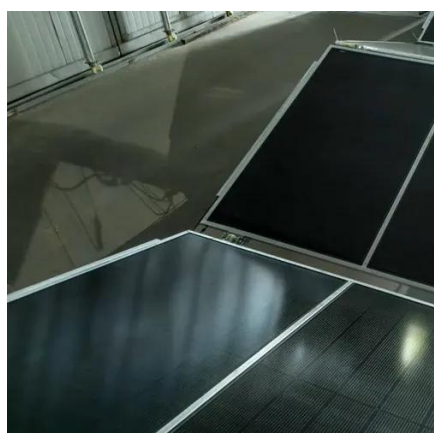

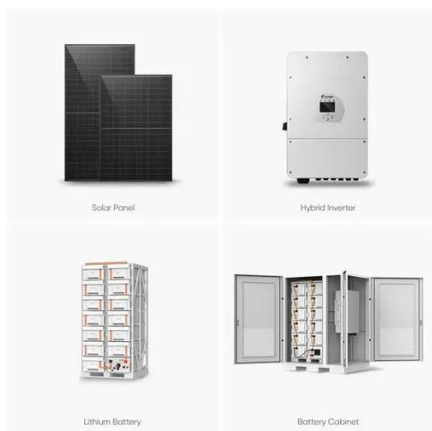
