Overview

When installing photovoltaic panels on one- and two-family homes, it's important to understand the requirements for access pathways and the requirements for setback from the ridge, which only apply to roofs with a slope greater than a 2-in-12 pitch. Access pathways are intended to provide access to. Coverage varies dramatically by installation type: Roof-mounted panels are typically covered under dwelling coverage with higher limits, while ground-mounted systems fall under “other structures” coverage limited to just 10% of your dwelling coverage—potentially leaving expensive systems.
