



Why is wind power generation declining





Overview

US wind power slipped last year for the first time in a quarter-century due to weaker-than-normal Midwest breezes, underscoring the challenge of integrating volatile renewable energy sources into the grid. Despite the installation of more and more wind turbines, wind production declined in July to a 33-month low. With windmill capacity increasing due to subsidies and. U. Data from our Power Plant Operations Report show that U. 2 billion kilowatt hours (kWh) of electricity in 2023— 2. fell to a 33-month low on Monday, forcing power generators to crank up natural-gas fired plants to keep air conditioners humming during a hot summer day. 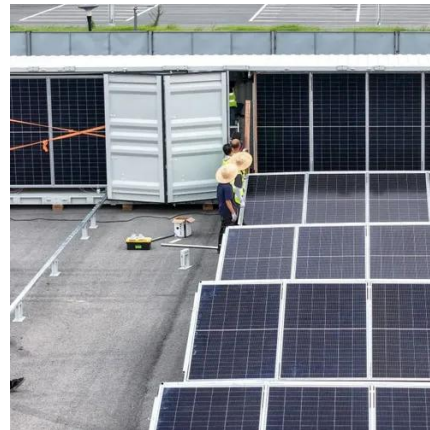
